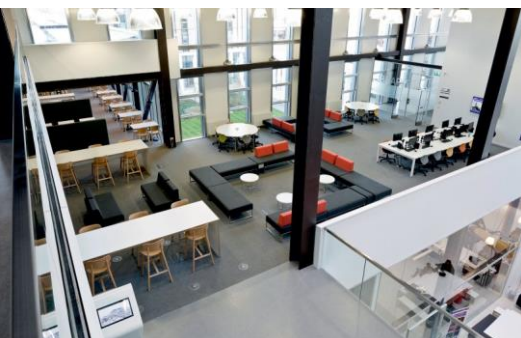

A TYPICAL DAY

Students have three hours of English lessons per day from Monday to Friday. Lessons are divided into two parts:
